


Background of the Partnership

With the Japanese government's commitment to achieving carbon neutrality by 2050, companies are being called upon to reduce CO2 emissions not only within their own operations but throughout their supply chains. Many are looking to accelerate decarbonization efforts by utilizing renewable energy sources.

However, a shortage of skilled personnel in the decarbonization field, or GX talent, has become a significant social issue. The renewable energy sector, particularly the wind power industry, faces an especially acute shortage due to the anticipated rise in power demand and decarbonization needs. By 2030, an estimated 16,000 workers will be needed in Japan's offshore wind power industry, growing to 38,000 by 2040 (as per October 2023 estimates from the Japan Wind Power Association). The demand for technical workers specializing in manufacturing, assembly, and O&M (operations and maintenance) is projected to be particularly strong.

Amid this growing need for GX talent development, ASUENE CAREER and Wind Power Group have partnered to create and deliver a one-stop solution for GX talent creation and supply to help alleviate this structural workforce shortage.



Details of the Partnership

Wind Power Group operates a fully integrated wind power business that spans EPC, O&M, and training. In January 2024, Wind Power Group opened a training center as GWO certified training provider, and in September 2024, it launched Japan's first online GWO Training Standard program. This pioneering program plays a vital role in producing skilled GX talent for the industry.

ASUENE provides various sustainability-focused solutions, including ASUENE, a carbon accounting platform, ASUENE ESG, a cloud service for ESG evaluation of supply chain procurement, and ASUENE CAREER, a hiring and recruitment platform specializing in GX and ESG fields.
